Year 1: Who is a Christian and what do they believe?

Core Learning of this unit

Children will:

- Talk about the fact that Christians believe in God and follow the example of Jesus
- Talk about some simple ideas about Christian beliefs about God and Jesus
- Recognise some Christian symbols and images used to express ideas about God
- Re-tell a story that shows what Christians might think about God, in words, drama and pictures, suggesting what it means
- Ask some questions about believing in God and offer some ideas of their own
- Talk about issues of good and bad, right and wrong arising from the stories

Prior Learning

They will have explored the past and present events and how children don't always enjoy the same things.

They have identified similarities between themselves and families, communities and traditions.

Key Vocabulary

Creation- is the making of the world by God

Prayer- request for help or expression of thanks to God or a god

Hymn - religious song or poem of praise to God or a god.

Harvest- the process or period of gathering in crops.

Advent-the period beginning four Sundays before Christmas, observed in commemoration of the coming of Christ into the world.

Ceremony- a formal religious or public occasion, especially one celebrating a particular event, achievement, or anniversary.

Old Testament-the first part of the Christian Bible

New Testament- the first part of the Christian Bible
