

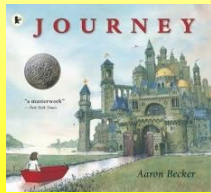
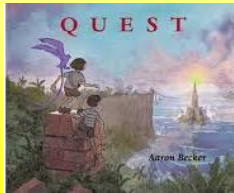
English
