

In Literacy, I will learn;

Some of our books will be:



- Continue to write my name (UF).
- How to form letters correctly.
- How to spell some HRSW.
- Continue to learn sounds and blend for reading.
- Write CVC and CCVC words independently.
- Begin to string words together to write phrases.

In Maths, I will learn:

LF:

- About the numbers 1 and 2
- To make amounts of these numbers.
- To subitise these numbers (recognise patterns of objects without needing to count).
- About different types of patterns.

UF:

- About numbers to 5
- Counting to 20 and beyond
- To name some 2D shapes (circles and triangles) and talk about their properties.
- Recognise these 2D shapes within some 3D shapes.

Our topics are: Bonfire Night/Diwali/Construction/Christmas!

In Physical Development, I will learn:

- How to improve my pencil grip by taking part in fine motor activities.
- How to build using various construction items – indoor and outdoor.
- PE – Gymnastics.



In Personal, Social and Emotional Development, I will learn:

- How to build up my resilience so I can persevere in the face of challenges.
- How to work collaboratively in a group to build with the construction materials; taking account of others ideas and compromising when necessary.

In Communication and Language, I will learn:

- To demonstrate good listening behaviours.
- To talk about my learning.
- To retell a known story.
- To answer questions about characters in a story.
- How use new vocabulary in context.

In Expressive Art and Design, I will learn:

- How to mix paints to make different colours.
- Talk to others about my artwork.
- Hold a range of materials effectively.
- Chose which tools to use to create my own pieces of art work.

In Understanding the World, I will learn:

- About Bonfire night and how we celebrate it.
- About buildings and the differences between them; height, purpose, scale etc.
- About the reasons we celebrate Christmas.
- Christmas traditions around the world.
